Treasurer's report: It was reported that NCCCAA spent a total of \$720.83 from 8/27/13 to 1/13/2014. The money was spent in regards to Artist's Alley, float signs, & luggage tags.

Old Business:

1. Golf Tournament- was held on April 26, 2014 at Ottawa. Twelve teams were present. All went well in regards to trophies and scholarships. The bills for this are not all in as of now. 3. Alumni Facebook Page-The idea for creating this is to serve as a means of communication between the college and the alumni and for the alumni to communicate with each other. The consensus was that this is a good idea and that we will need permission from the NCCC Foundation to do this.
4. Annual Meeting-The next meeting is the annual meeting at which time officers are elected. It was mentioned that we need to recruit potential board members who are graduates of the Ottawa

campus. Alumni Board Secretary Brad Johnson announced that he wishes to resign his position as board secretary and yet remain on the board.

Miscellaneous Informational Items

1. On May 15th John Mohn, class of 59 was inducted as the distinguished Alumnus.
2. Graduation was held on May 16th.
3. On May 20th a retirement party was held on the Chanute campus for Joan La Rue and Paul Smith. Joan played a big role in the college's nursing program. Paul retired as maintenance supervisor.

5. We donated alumni pens for the March AKCCOP (Association of Kansas Community College Occupational Professionals).
