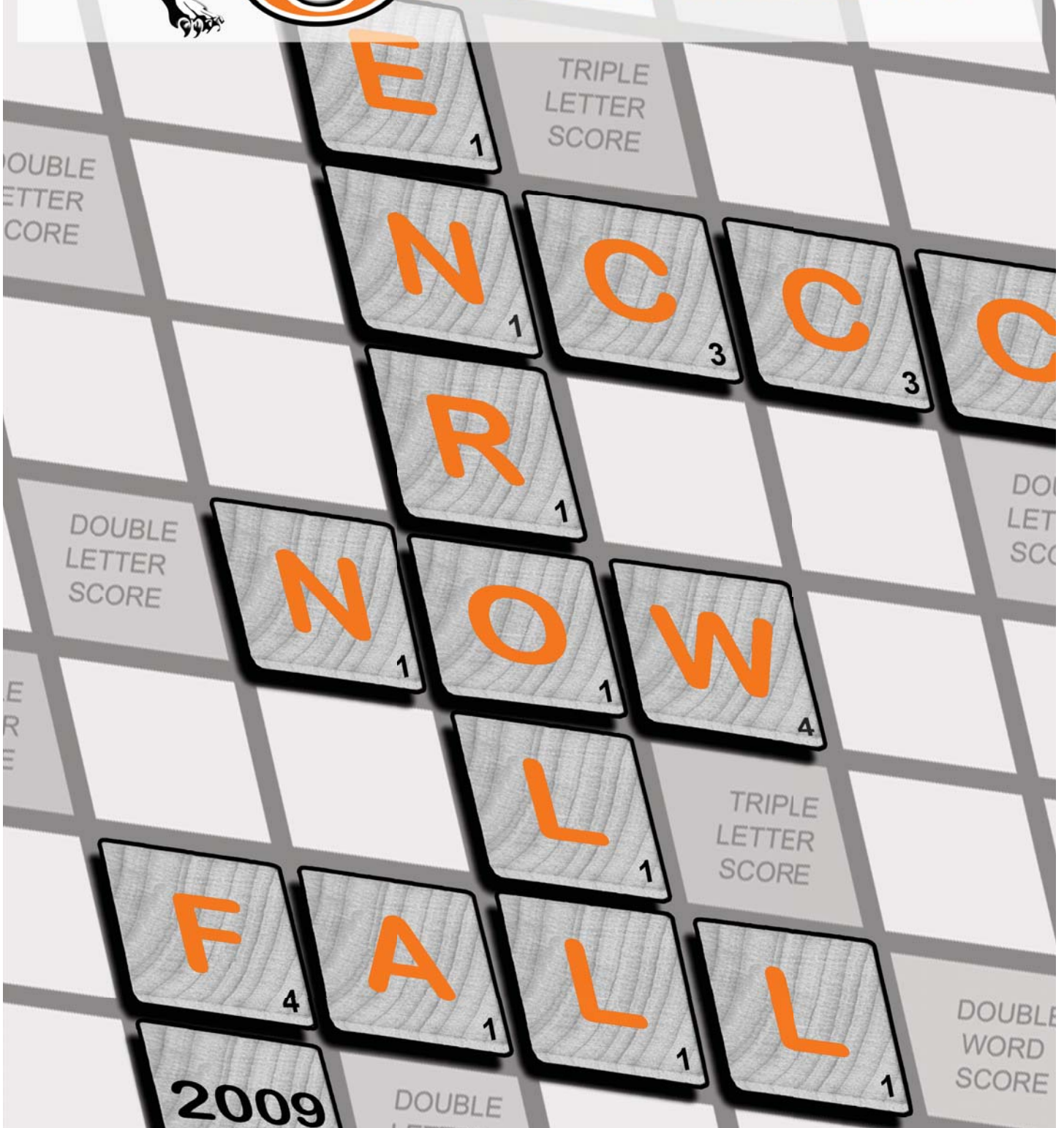

INSTITUTIONAL REFUND POLICY

(revised 4/13/2000)(revised 1-15-04)

The registrar's office is the official office for withdrawal notification. Refunds are calculated based on the day a student officially drops a class by contacting the registrar's office in person, by mail, or by phone. A full refund will be issued if NCCC exercises its right to cancel a class. If a student withdraws from a class, the student may receive a refund. Some fees are not refundable.

Courses 16 or more weeks in duration:

If a student has completed registration and wishes to withdraw from a class or classes in which they are enrolled, the student will receive the following refund: 100% refund if the completed drop form is received by the registration office within two weeks (14 calendar days) of the official start date of classes, as published. Sept. 4, 2009 will be the last day for 100% refund for the Fall 2009 semester. Classes beginning after the official start date will be dealt with on an individual basis. **No refund** will be given after the end of the two-week refund period.

Courses less than 16 weeks in duration(mini courses):

A full refund will be made for withdrawals prior to or on the first day of class. No refund will be given after the first day of class.

Refunds will be disbursed beginning Friday, Sept. 11, 2009 for the Fall 2009 semester.

Exceptions to this policy may be authorized by the chief financial officer.

FALL 2009 PAYMENT INFORMATION

Payment for Fall 2009 classes is due on or before July 25, 2009.

By July 25, students must:

- ◆ Pay in full;
- ◆ Complete an "Installment Payment Plan" contract & pay 1/3 of total balance due + \$35 payment plan fee; OR
- ◆ Have in place financial aid to cover all Fall charges (must have a complete financial aid file).

Students who do not meet one of the above criteria by July 25 may be dropped from their spring classes. Students who are dropped may re-enroll after payment arrangements are made.

Billing

Neosho County Community College sends out billing statements around the 15th of each month. Questions about your statement? Call 620-431-2820 ext. 286.

If a check made payable to the college is returned for any reason, your records will be placed on hold, and you will be charged a return check fee of \$30 for each returned check.

If the check for your tuition and fees is returned, you will be assessed the \$30 return check fee. Your records will be placed on hold until you pay the return check fee and all outstanding NCCC financial obligations. Once you have a returned check, the college will accept only cash, money order, MasterCard, Visa, or Discover payments and American Express.

You will be notified at your current student address if your check is returned. If the payment is not made to the college within 10 days, the matter may be referred to a collection agency.

STEPS TO ENROLL

- 1. Complete an admission form.** Apply online by visiting www.neosho.edu, or call (620) 431-2820 or 800-729-6222, ext. 233 to request a form. Students seeking a degree at NCCC must submit their high school transcripts, as well as transcripts from all former colleges attended.
- 2. Apply for financial aid and scholarships.** Priority deadline for preferred grants and scholarships is four months prior to any regular enrollment period. Applications received after the priority deadline are not guaranteed timely disbursement. Contact the financial aid office at ext. 278 for more information.
- 3. Take a placement exam or provide us with your ACT scores.** All students enrolling in math or English courses must provide ACT/SAT or COMPASS scores that are sufficient for placement into the chosen course. COMPASS testing is offered on the NCCC campus Monday through Thursday from 8 am to 3 pm. Students needing to take the COMPASS should report to the Welcome Center in the Student Union. COMPASS testing generally takes 1- 1 1/2 hours to complete.
- 4. Schedule an advising appointment to plan your class schedule.** Call the student services office at 620-431-2820, ext. 280 or 233, to schedule an advising appointment.
- 5. Pay for your courses. Payment for Fall classes is due July 25.** All students who have not paid in full, signed up for the installment payment plan and paid 1/3 of their spring charges + \$35 payment plan fee, or have financial aid in place to cover all charges by July 25 may be dropped from their classes. Students enrolling as of July 1, 2009 must pay in full or sign up for the installment payment plan and pay 1/3 of the balance due + \$35 payment plan fee at the time of enrollment or have financial aid in place to cover all charges. NCCC accepts VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express
- 6. Rent/Purchase your books at the NCCC Bookstore.** Online students may call the bookstore at (620) 431-2820 ext. 247 for textbook information.
- 7. You're ready for class! Have a great semester!**

ENROLLING ONLINE

- 1. See your advisor to plan your class schedule.**
- 2. Your advisor will then enter a registration code** or he/she will sign your enrollment form for you to take to the Student Services office where your registration code will be entered.
- 3. Log in to Inside NC.**
- 4. Click on the Student tab.**
- 5. Click on Course Search.**
- 6. Be sure the term in the drop down box is the term for which you wish to register.** If not, choose the correct term.
- 7. From Course Search, you can enter a specific course to add** or view the entire course schedule and add courses from there.
- 8. If you view the entire course schedule, an Add button should appear in red to the left of the course number.** NOTE: If you have a hold of any kind, you will not see the red Add buttons. You will also not be able to add classes via the web if there is a time conflict between any of the classes you are adding.
