

# AA in Music

The AA in Music is designed to prepare students for a transfer to a four-year institution. The courses required are a basic foundation on which one can build.

## PREREQUISITES

You will need to demonstrate proficiencies in reading, English, and mathematics based on the COMPASS assessment test, ACT or SAT scores, or by taking the recommended/required classes. Some of the courses in this curriculum have specific prerequisites. Prerequisites can be found on the reverse side (Guide to Completing Program Requirements) or in the college catalog.

## GENERAL EDUCATION (GE) COURSES

In order to graduate with a college degree, all students are required to take certain general education courses. These include courses in English composition, speech, wellness, science, art & humanities, mathematics, computer systems, and social & behavioral sciences.

## PROGRAM CORE COURSES

The core courses are taken from music. Those courses are the fundamental building block to work towards a four-year degree.
