

## Student's "Right to Know" Information

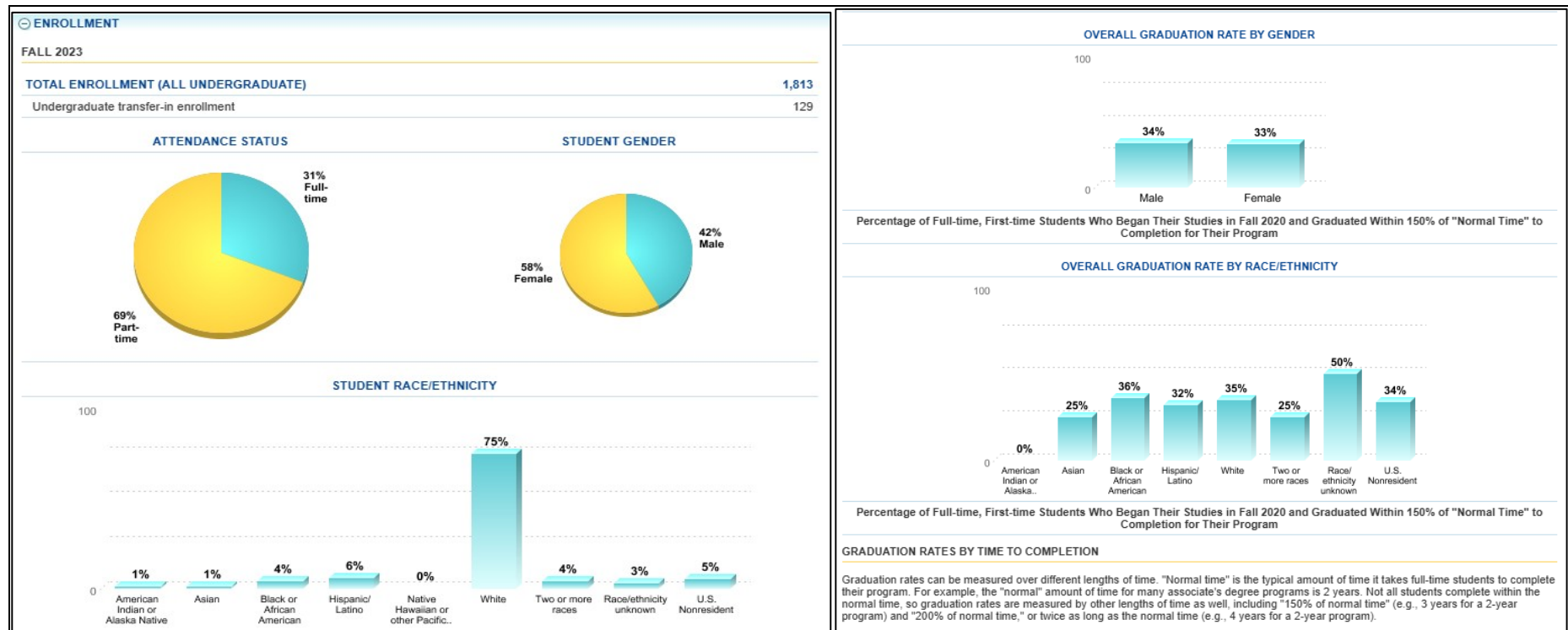
