



Voter Registration Information

Register to Vote

A valid Kansas driver's license or ID card is required to register to vote. Voters who do not have a Kansas license or ID card must complete the paper form. Those who do have a Kansas driver's license or ID card may register online. Re-registration is required each time a voter changes their name, address, or party affiliation.

Voting

Kansas voters must show photo ID when casting a vote in person. The following documents may be used:

- ◆ Driver's license or ID card
- ◆ U.S. passport
- ◆ U.S. military ID
- ◆ ID card issued by Native American tribe
- ◆ Employee badge or ID issued by a government office
- ◆ Student ID card from an accredited postsecondary education institution in Kansas
- ◆ Concealed carry license
- ◆ Public assistance ID card issued by a government office

Exemptions from photo ID requirements apply to voters with illness or disabilities requiring advance voting, military/overseas voters and their spouses and dependents; and voters with religious beliefs which prohibit photographic identification who sign a Declaration of Religious Objection. Voters 65 and older may use an expired photo ID.
