



2021-2022 FAFSA Verification of Income

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What is Verification?

Your application has been selected for a review process called "Verification." Since you did not use the Data Retrieval Tool, the Office of Student Financial Aid (OSFA) at NCCC must compare information from your FAFSA with copies of your and your spouse's (if married) signed **2019** federal tax return, schedules 1, 2 and 3, W-2s, and/or other financial documents. Section 483 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, gives us the authority to ask for this information before awarding federal aid.

The OSFA will compare the submitted documents to your FAFSA information. If there are any discrepancies, the OSFA may request further clarification. If corrections are needed, the OSFA will make them on your behalf. **No federal financial aid will be awarded to you until the verification process is complete.**

What you need to do:

1. Submit a copy of your 2019 W-2s and your signed 2019 federal income tax return including schedules 1, 2 and 3. If you are a non-tax filer submit W-2s and provide documentation from the IRS, or other relevant tax authority, dated on or after October 1, 2020 that indicates a 2019 IRS income tax return was not filed with the IRS or other relevant tax authority.
2. Complete and sign this worksheet.
3. Submit the completed worksheet and copies of signed 2019 tax return including schedules 1, 2 and 3, W-2s and other documents to the NCCC OSFA as soon as possible so that your aid will not be delayed.
