Neosho County Community College welcomes applicants for the part-time position of Developmental Education instructor to teach various developmental reading and writing courses.

Minimum qualifications:

**100 level coursework requires Master's degree with at least 18 graduate hours in ENGL

*000 level courses require a Bachelor's with at least 24 undergraduate hours in the ENGL
Previous successful college level teaching preferred.

Adjunct faculty may be assigned to teach up to 10 credit hours a semester. Courses may be scheduled anytime during the academic day or evening depending on adjunct instructor's and/or college schedule. Fall 2022 classes have been prescheduled. Future teaching assignments may include the option of hybrid, or online classes, depending on the needs of the college and the interest and/or experience of the instructor.

Paid professional tutor positions may also be available through the TLC (Teaching and Learning Center) at an hourly compensation rate of \$12/hr.

Starting Date: beginning Fall Semester 2022, renewable each semester as needed.

Application Deadline: Review of applications and interviews of qualified candidates will begin immediately and continue until position is filled.
