Minimum Qualifications: Master's degree in field preferred or master's degree with 18 graduate hours in field required. Previous successful college level teaching experience preferred.

Adjunct faculty may be assigned to teach up to 9 hours a semester, including collateral assignments in appropriately certified areas of interest. Courses may be scheduled anytime during the academic day or evening depending on adjunct instructor's and/or college schedule. Fall 2022 classes have been prescheduled. Future teaching assignment may include the option of hybrid, virtual, or online classes, depending on the needs of the college and the interest and/or experience of the instructor.

Starting Date: Beginning Fall Semester 2022, renewable each semester as needed.

Application Deadline: Review of applications and interviews of qualified candidates will begin immediately and continue until position is filled.
