***Curriculum Sequence Plan***

Required general courses may be completed at an accredited college of the student's choice. A minimum grade of "C" is required in each of the courses listed below. The science courses (Human Anatomy and Physiology and Microbiology w/labs) must be taken within seven years of beginning the nursing program. These courses are sequential and must be completed in the semester listed, if not already completed, before progressing to the next semester. Courses with the prefix "NURS" are specific to the nursing program and must be completed at Neosho County Community College. The nursing program is divided into two years.
