

Complete in the following order:

- Apply to Neosho County Community College** Apply on-line at: www.neosho.edu
- Provide scores for Accuplacer, Compass or ACT/SAT** Scores must be within the last 3 years. Have you already successfully completed English Comp I and a college level math course? If so, you do not need to provide these placement scores and may skip this step.
- Send official transcripts** from ALL colleges attended and high school or GED. Please send **directly to the nursing department**. High school/GED/Home School may be faxed from school.
- Attend a Bridge Information Meeting.** Required
- Take the following pre-requisites. A grade of “C” or better is required in all courses.** You may apply before pre-requisites are completed. All pre-requisites must be completed before starting the nursing program.

- Completion of the following courses increases points toward application placement:**

NURS 230	Pathophysiology	3	A&P with Lab is a pre-requisite. Must be completed within 3 years of starting the nursing program.
BIOL 271	Microbiology	3	Must be completed within 7 years of starting the nursing program. Online labs are discouraged
BIOL 272	Microbiology Lab	2	
ENGL 289	English Composition II	3	

A computer course is required to complete the nursing program. Completion of this course does not increase points toward application, but it is necessary to have in order to graduate. NCCC courses accepted: CSIS 100 – Computer Concepts & Applications or CSIS 105 - Computer Literacy from NCCC only. For the purposes of the nursing program, a test-out option is available for the Computer Literacy course only. Please contact the CLC or TLC to schedule a test out.

- Apply to the nursing program.**
 - Application may be downloaded from www.neosho.edu Departments/Nursing/LPN to RN/ Bridge Application.
 - Applicant must have graduated an accredited high school, home school, or have their GED.
 - Must be a graduate of a PN program and hold a current LPN license.

- Applicant must meet the requirements of the KSBN Articulation Agreement for acceptance into our nursing program. <http://www.ksbn.org/education/Resources/NursingArticulation.pdf>
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to be considered for admission.
- Submit application and non-refundable application fee.
- Applications are accepted only during the application period:

- **Complete the nursing entrance exam – PN Comprehensive Assessment.** After you have submitted your nursing application and application fee, once your application has been processed, you will be contacted via email with PN Comprehensive testing dates.
 - This is a timed, 3 hour, computerized exam.
 - **Studying is HIGHLY recommended.** Any LPN or RN NCLEX comprehensive review book will work as a study guide. Exam may only be taken ONE (1) time per application year at NCCC.
 - Exam score must be above the national mean to be eligible to continue to the Medical Calculations exam.
- **Complete Medical Calculation exam.**
 - Applicant must pass exam with 95% accuracy to be eligible for the Bridge program.
 - This exam may be taken a total of 3 times. Exam dates will be provided in email along with PN Comprehensive dates.
- **Student Selection is completed by the Nursing Administrative Team. Items reviewed for admission placement include:**
 - Punctuality
 - Application properly completed and received by deadline
 - Official transcripts (high school & all colleges) received by the application deadline
 - Accuplacer, Compass, ACT or SAT scores submitted, or math and English courses completed and on official transcripts
 - General education courses completed for the nursing program
 - GPA of general education courses completed
 - Overall GPA
 - Nurse entrance exam (PN Comprehensive) score
 - Medical Calculation exam score

Applicants will receive a letter regarding acceptance: By the first week of April
