- Apply to Neosho County Community College** Apply on-line at: www.neosho.edu
- Send official transcripts** from ALL colleges attended and high school or GED. Please send **directly to the nursing department**. High school/GED/Home School may be faxed from school.
- Attendance is Required at a Nursing Information Meeting on either Campus.**
- Take the following pre-requisites. A grade of “C” or better is required in all general education courses. Pathophysiology requires 80% or higher pass rate to be accepted.**

You may apply before pre-requisites are completed. All pre-requisites must be completed before starting the nursing program.

PSYC 263	Developmental Psychology	3	Recommend completing this course before starting the nursing program.
NURS 230	Pathophysiology (80% or higher is required to pass.)	3	A&P with Lab is a pre-requisite. Completed within 3 years of starting the nursing program.
BIOL 271	Microbiology	3	Completed within 7 years of starting the nursing program. Online labs are highly discouraged.
BIOL 272	Microbiology Lab	2	
ENGL 289	English Composition II	3	

A computer course is required to complete the nursing program. Completion of this course does not increase points toward application, but it is necessary to have in order to graduate. NCCC courses accepted: CSIS 100 – Computer Concepts & Applications or CSIS 105 - Computer Literacy from NCCC only accepted.

- Apply to the nursing program.**
 - Application may be downloaded from www.neosho.edu Departments/Nursing/Admissions-Generic Student Application.
 - Applicant must be a graduate of an accredited high school, home school, or have their GED.
 - Applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to be considered for admission.
 - **Must have completed or be enrolled in A&P w/Lab they semester student applies to the nursing program.**
 - Submit application and non-refundable application fee. Applications are accepted only during the application period:

- Complete the nursing entrance exam.** After you have submitted your nursing application and application fee, once your application has been processed, you will be contacted via email with TEAS testing dates. TEAS stands for Test of Essential Academic Skills. This is a timed (2 hour), computerized exam.
 - **Studying is HIGHLY recommended.** Study guides (TEAS book) for the exam are available through the NCCC bookstore. ATI TEAS practice exams and study guides are available for purchase at www.atitesting.com/onlinestore.
 - The TEAS covers several topics, however we only test the **math and reading sections**.
 - Exam may only be taken ONE (1) time per application year at NCCC.
- ATI A & P Exam will be taken after passing the TEAS Test. Best to use A&P notes and book.**
- Student Selection is completed by the Nursing Administrative Team. Items reviewed for admission placement include:**
 - Punctuality
 - Application properly completed and received by deadline
 - Official transcripts (high school & all colleges) received by the application deadline
 - General education courses completed for the nursing program
 - GPA of general education courses completed
 - Overall GPA
 - Nurse entrance tests ATI TEAS & A & P scores

Applicants will receive a letter indicating the decision/recommendations regarding acceptance:
