

Grade Points

Students will have their grade-point averages computed on the following basis – for each credit hour of A, 4 points; B, 3 points, C, 2 points; D, 1 point; F, no points. In order for students to have a C average and be eligible for graduation, they must have a minimum of sixty-four (64)-college hours and 128 grade points. The grade-point average is the quotient obtained by dividing the number of grade points earned by the number of credit hours for which grades A, B, C, D, or F are recorded. Where a student re-enrolls in a course in which a D or F grade has been received, the most recent grade earned will be used in computing grade-point average.
