### Seamless AGREEMENT

Between

Allen County Community College

AND

Neosho County Community College

This agreement, by and between Allen County Community College (ACCC) and Neosho County Community College (NCCC) is made to provide NCCC students enrolling in the ACCC Early Childhood Education Program, a seamless transfer of general education college credits towards the Associate of Applied Science Degree.

The ACCC Early Childhood Education Program will provide courses meeting the standards for the Child Development Associate training and the Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals in Kansas and Missouri.

Students, who complete the 16 credit hour general education coursework (outlined below) and the 44 credit hour ECE core coursework, will earn the Associate of Applied Science Degree from ACCC.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:




2. ACCC will provide college courses as equivalent for the ECE components which meets the Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals in Kansas and Missouri.

4. NCCC will supply ACCC all the above NCCC course syllabi with no exchange of reimbursement between the institutions. ACCC will supply NCCC the above ACCC course syllabi with no exchange of reimbursement between the institutions.
5. A maximum of 16 credits may be transferred to ACCC and applied toward this AAS degree. Sixteen of the last 28 credit hours applied toward graduation must be taken at ACCC.
6. This agreement may be revised or discontinued by either party or by mutual agreement, prior to each academic year, and shall be modified in the event of cancellation, discontinuance or disapproval of any course or program by the colleges or the Kansas Board of Regents.
7. This agreement will be reviewed annually by the parties involved.

This agreement, by and between Allen County Community College (ACCC) and Neosho County Community College (NCCC) is made to provide NCCC students enrolling in the ACCC Addiction and Prevention Studies Program, a seamless transfer of general education college credits towards the Associate of Applied Science Degree.

The ACCC Addiction and Prevention Studies Program will provide courses meeting the acceptable standards for the Addiction and Prevention training and the Core Competencies for Kansas Association of Addiction Professionals.

Students, who complete the 22 credit hour general education coursework (outlined below) and the 38 credit hour APS core coursework, will earn the Associate of Applied Science Degree from ACCC.


2. ACCC will provide college courses as equivalent for the APS components which meets the Core Competencies for Kansas Association of Addiction Professionals.



4. NCCC will inform ACCC when changes to the general education requirements for the NCCC nursing program occur, supplying specific change information.
5. Students applying to the NCCC nursing program must also have CNA certification prior to making application.
6. Both parties may advertise this agreement and will advise students that this option is available.
7. ACCC will supply NCCC all the above ACCC course syllabi with no exchange of reimbursement between the institutions. NCCC will supply ACCC the above NCCC course syllabi with no exchange of reimbursement between the institutions.
8. A maximum of 28 credits may be transferred to NCCC and applied as general education requirements for the Applied Science Degree in Nursing.
9. This agreement may be revised or discontinued by either party or by mutual agreement, prior to each academic year, and shall be modified in the event of cancellation, discontinuance or disapproval of any course or program by the colleges or the Kansas Board of Regents.
10. This agreement will be reviewed annually by the parties involved.




