

General Education Articulation Agreement
Between Neosho County Community College
and Newman University

1. Newman University (NU) assures the acceptance of any Neosho County Community College (NCCC) Associate of Arts and Associate of Science graduate as a baccalaureate degree-seeking student with junior standing.
2. Beginning with the 2012-2013 academic year, NU accepts the Associate of Arts degree and Associate of Science degrees as meeting the Newman Studies Skills and General Education requirements except philosophy and theology which will be evaluated separately. All upper level (300 and 400 level) Newman Studies Core requirements must be met on the same basis as any other NU student.
3. Some NU degree programs have specific General Education and grade point average requirements. NCCC graduates entering these programs must meet these requirements to be part of these degree programs. NCCC students who anticipate transferring to NU should plan their General Education programs accordingly, including lower level courses required in the intended major.
4. The NCCC Associate of Applied Arts and Sciences graduates are not included in this agreement. NU will assess the records of these graduates on an individual basis.
5. NCCC and NU will include information about this agreement in their college catalogs.
6. This agreement will be reviewed biennially, and may be revised by mutual consent.
7. The agreement will continue in force indefinitely, but may be terminated by either party with notice of at least two years.

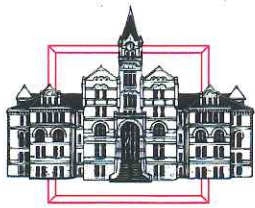





**Transfer Agreement and Articulation Guide
Between
Friends University College of Adult and Professional Studies (CAPS)
And
Neosho County Community College**

A student who completes an Associate's degree (AAS, AA, AS, AGS) from Neosho County Community College will be accepted with junior standing and will have satisfied the general education requirements of Friends University College of Adult and Professional Studies (CAPS) with the understanding that:

- a) Friends University CAPS has the right to determine admission standards to the various majors within the college.
- b) Transfer students are subject to the same institutional policies and procedures as resident students of Friends University CAPS.
- c) A minimum of 37 credit hours of general education with distribution in the following fields is required:
 - 6 hours of English Composition
 - 3 hours of Public Speaking or Speech Communication
 - 3 hours of college level Mathematics
 - 3 Computer Information Systems
 - 9 hours of Humanities courses from Art, Theater, Music, Literature, Foreign Language, or History (performance courses are excluded; minimum two categories)
 - 3 hours of Religion or Philosophy
 - 6 hours of Social and Behavioral Science from Sociology, Psychology, Political Science, Economics, Geography, or Anthropology
 - 4 hours of Natural Science with lab

Students transferring to Friends University from Neosho County Community College who have not completed an Associate's degree will be given general education credit for any articulated general education course completed at Neosho County Community College. Students may transfer up to 78 credit hours from two-year institutions.
