



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between**

Neosho County Community College and Missouri Southern State University

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to define a smooth transfer process for Neosho County Community College (NCCC) international students to Missouri Southern State University (MSSU), both accredited institutions of higher education. This document serves for the purpose of outlining application procedures, admission requirements and transfer processes for international applicants.

Under this agreement, MSSU will admit qualified NCCC students who meet the following requirements.

Admission Requirements:

- Completion of a NCCC associate degree **OR** planned completion of a NCCC associate degree prior to enrollment at MSSU.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and must have a GPA of 2.0 in their last enrollment term at NCCC prior to transferring to MSSU.
- MSSU qualifying TOEFL or IELTS score **OR** Completion of NCCC English 101 and English 289 and receiving a minimum grade of C to transfer.
- Meet coursework prerequisites for desired major.
- Submit a complete transfer application and all required documents by the applicable admissions deadlines.
- Pay the application fee.

Required Documents:

- Official transcripts from NCCC
- Proof of language proficiency (Transcript with appropriate coursework) or (TOEFL/IELTS)
- Evidence of financial support (bank statement and MSSU declaration of financial support)
- Copy of passport Bio page

Upon completion of the above requirements and verification of transfer credits from NCCC to MSSU, the applicant will be admitted to MSSU for completion of a baccalaureate degree subject to the policies of MSSU.

Missouri Southern State University will offer the Board of Governor’s Transfer Scholarship and the University Academic Transfer Scholarship to international students who meet the scholarship credit hour and GPA requirements:

Board of Governor’s Transfer Scholarship


- Transferring in at least 42 credit hours and have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

University Academic Transfer Scholarship

- Transferring in at least 24 credit hours and a 3.25 or higher.

Missouri Southern State University will offer in-state tuition plus 10% of the out-of-state tuition cost to transfer international students from NCCC.

This memorandum of understanding is effective on the date of signature and will remain in effect for five years. Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason with 30 days written notice to the other.
