

Vehicle Permit Application

Neosho County Community College Residence Halls

Overnight parking on Neosho County Community College's campus is by permit only and restricted to areas in parking lot #4 on the East side of Bideau Hall, designated by signs reading "**Residence Hall Parking**". Any overflow parking will be located in parking lot #3 on West side of Bideau Hall, designated by parking spaces painted with "**Reserved Residents**". The student will be issued a parking permit by a Safety Officer. Any student planning to keep a car in overnight **MUST** park in the designated area. **Keeping public parking open in P3 is non-negotiable.** It must be accomplished by everyone involved, especially the vehicle owners. *Any questions or complaints can be voiced to the Safety Officer on duty.* Cars parked in the designated resident parking areas must have permit visible in the front driver side windshield. Any vehicle that does not have a parking permit attached will be towed at the owner's expense. Any vehicle with a parking permit parked in an incorrect spot will be given a warning/ticket issued by the on duty Safety Officer.
