Call to order: The quarterly meeting of the NCCC Alumni Association was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Mike Sutcliffe, president in room 213 at NCCC.

Approval of Agenda: On a motion by Dwight Smith, seconded by Linus Thuston the agenda was approved as printed.

Minutes: On a motion by Sharon Reaves, seconded by Dwight Smith the notes from the November meeting were accepted.

Old Business:

New Business:

1. Selection of the 2013 distinguished alumnus- The association discussed the nominees and after written ballot Vivian Rowan was selected as the 2013 distinguished alumnus. If Mrs. Rowan does not accept the second place nominee will be contacted.
